Trailmaster's Report:

Carol walked Seneca Trail with Chris Agar from Nature Conservancy. Walk was good, but discussion about trail in Bentley Woods was not. See New Business note.

Trail Boss' Report:

ISTEA- Larry said Paul Van Scott would talk to Phil Clark to see what we need to do to save the stone bridge.

Larry was pleased with the amount of use that the trails are getting.

Maintenance will continue according to schedule.

Last Hike:

6 members drove to Dresden and hiked the Outlet Trail to Penn Yan. Many old buildings and foundations remain from as early as 1810. Great trail for biking and cross-country skiing,

Old Business:

Dave passed around a sign-up sheet for Hang Around Victor.

Dave called John Erickson of Auburn Golf Driving Range to let him know that we did not want the conservation property and that he might want to call Genesee Land Trust and Finger Lakes Trust.

New Business:

Village Park- Dave got a call from Charlie Criss who is putting together a grant proposal for purchasing 34 acres of land adjoining the Village's 9 acres and fronting on Brace Road. This would give access to the park and more land to develop into a passive park. The land has woods, fields and wet land, all suitable for trails. Charlie would like VHT to submit a letter of support for the grant. Dave will put something together.

Welcome wagon needs 100 VHT brochures. When they are printed, Dave will deliver them to the Town Hall for pick-up.

Dave sent a thank you to Brian Roberts of Trillium Trail for helping to mow a section of the Seneca Trail near Willowbrook.

Cresent Trails will meet the "End-to-End" Canalway Trail Trek bikers on Sunday, Sept. 14th at 1:30 PM in Perinton Park.

Dave received a nice letter thanking us for the Auburn East Trail. It will be in the next newsletter.

The Nature Conservancy is holding their annual meeting at Ganondagan on Sat., Sept. 20 from 10:30 AM to 1:00 PM. They are sponsoring a hike at Bentley Woods at 1:30 PM. Jeff hiked the Genesee Greenway from Scottsville to Avon.

Chauncy will be helping Pack, Paddle and Ski with a hike on the Greenway from Route 251 to Letchworth (22 miles).

Larry would like to schedule the boardwalk construction (Seneca Trail in the wetland area) and the Great Brook bridge for Oct. We need to get landowners permission for the bridge location.

Next Hike:

Sept. 13- Hike the Irondequoit Bay Park East trails. These are hilly narrow trails that wind through woods and end at the edge of the Bay. Meet at Victor Town hall at 9 AM and car pool to site.
