All trails have been checked for clearing from ice storm.

One change in the schedule- May 21. Clear the Trolley Trail in Brace Road Park. Meet at 6 PM at the East Street entrance. OK to drive in on the grass. Need chain saw.

Trailer- Still looking for a trailer. Tractor Supply has a 5' x 8' with drop-down ramp for a good price. Larry is getting a hitch for his van.

Domine Trail: plan to clear using ADK help.

Jason Bowerman, a scout with Troop 30 in Canandaigua and a Farmington resident, has decided to clear the trail from County Road 41 to the Apple Farm, along Great Brook, about .6 miles. Dave W. signed his Eagle workbook. He needs to get scoutmaster and district approval. We will need to cross a small drainage ditch at the north end. It will need a bridge to get across Great Brook at the south end.

### Last Hike:

18 hikers made the journey to Chimney Bluffs State Park, east of Sodus Bay on Lake Ontario. There were some downed trees and branches at the beginning of the trail, but we managed to get by them without any problems. The group enjoyed lunch on the beach and a nice walk back to the cars along the beach.

#### **Old Business:**

Lehigh Crossing Park Bridge- Beaver dam is back and causing flooding near the bridge.

**Monkey Run Trail-** Trail will be closed for this season due to construction of the sewer line. The entrance at Valentown Road is open.

Special National Trails Day shirts arrived. All helpers will get one.

We have a large display board of the Auburn-Lehigh Trail Enhancement project, thanks to Fishers Associates.
