Nine hikers started out at 10am on the FLT at the DEC station on Route 245 in Naples. Two dropped out, but the rest hiked to the top, had lunch, hiked the upper part of Conklin's Gully until about 2pm, then headed back to the cars, arriving around 4pm. Old Business:

Auburn Trail Priority Study- A final report was given to the three towns for a basis for future grants.

Auburn TEP Grant- Construction continues on the Lehigh from Old Dutch Road to the trestle. Herbicides were sprayed. The center was rolled. Base stone has been placed and rolled. Stone dust to be spread and rolled. Check out the photo album on our website www.victorhikingtrails.org.

GPS- Waiting for Kristin Bennett to reply to our request for master plan suggestions. We will collect the data for the new trail at Monkey Run.

Bridge Inventory- Will do Monkey Run, Bluebird, Lehigh Crossing, Seneca Trail South and 100 Acres in Oct. and Nov.

Oldcastle Domine Trail- Chauncy will stop by to see if they are still interested in giving us permission for a trail.

Eagle Project- Chris Bocchino will be making one or two benches for MaryFrances Bluebird Haven.

Autumn Weekend in the Adirondacks- Eight from Victor joined Marcia for a great hike up Gothics. 3 also did Armstrong and Upper Wolf Jaw. Dave Coleman also did Lower Wolf Jaw. On Sunday, 6 did Ampersand. Pictures are on the website. **Feet for Food-** This was a very successful fund raiser. Over \$12,000 was collected for the Victor-Farmington Food Cupboard. Thanks to all that contributed.

Trail Maps using GPS- Jeff is checking to see if he can use the raw data to create maps for VHT.

Empire Pipeline Project- The proposed pipe will be close to Monkey Run and MaryFrancis Bluebird Haven.

Grant Opportunity-

The American Hiking Society has some grant money available. We will submit an application to pay for the materials for the bridge over Great Brook at the Apple Farm, so we can continue the trail south toward Boughton Park.

Genesee Region Trails Coalition and Genesee Waterways Center hosted a two-day meeting with local trail leaders and the Ontario (Canada) Trails Council at the GWC. It was a great exchange of information and ideas. The next meeting will be Nov. 20 and 21 in Canada.
