The section from School St. to Maple Ave. will now use the trolley trail instead of the railroad bed. After the bridge on Rt. 96 by Brace Road is repaired and opened, Maple Ave will be re-striped on both sides to change the bike lanes from 2 feet to 4 feet.

Lehigh Trestle Decking-

We have construction plans and a material list from Joe Logan. Brian, Chauncy and Dave W. met last week to discuss responsibilities, cost, schedule. Brian is getting prices from 3 different places. He is also checking on getting an inspection of the bridge. He has been talking to SwiftLift about a manlift to make the job easier and faster. He will also check with O'Connell Electric. Tenative work dates are October 5, 6, 7, 12, 13 and 14.
