EDUCATION: Ruth reported that the Teen Adventure Club is winding down for the summer and will start again in the fall. We will finish the work on the Victor Municipal Park trail.

NEWSLETTER: Dave Wright – Working on the summer 2009 issue. There will be reports on our events and trail work.

TRAILMASTER: Carol will try to revive our request for a trail in Bentley Woods. We are waiting to hear from the town on the Domine trail. Chauncy will meet with Ebett Judson to work on a trail from the Apple Farm to Boughton Park. Larry will ask Iron Butterfly Health Club if we can extend the Trolley Trail to their parking lot. Jeff will ask the Best Western if we can cut across their property to avoid the Quik Fill gas station.

TRAIL BOSS: Chauncy's report- There was lots of trail work and bench work in preparation for National Trails Day. The bench at Fishers is complete and looks good. The pad for the Victor bench is

poured and ready for the bench. Work is scheduled for 5:00 pm on 6/24/09.

Auburn Trail from Mickey Finn's to Farmington town line needs mowing on the edge. Is the town planning to mow soon? Note sent to Brian E.

No mowing planned for July 4th. We will get it done before then.

Work on new trail at Victor Municipal Park will take place on Thursday, June 25 at 9:00 a.m. at the East Street entrance.

The sign at Royal View trailhead will be moved closer to the road and several blue stakes will be installed.

The Seneca Trail at Auburn Creek Driving Range needs several red topped stakes. Blazing needed through the woods to the Auburn Trail connection. The section from Willowbrook to Rt. 96 needs cleaning.

The small hedge trimmer is being repaired. Motion by Dave, seconded by Larry and approved to purchase a new hedge trimmer up to \$250.00 if the old one is not repairable or will cost more than \$250.00.

Billy Goat- New skids were ordered and have been received.

LAST HIKES: June 6- National Trails Day had 35 hikers for the first leg, over 20 for the second hike and about 10 for the last hike. If you did all 3 (about six did), you covered about 10 miles.

June 7- Train ride to Canandaigua and back. There were 12 bike riders (3 rode their bikes back to Victor), 4 hikers and about 50 passengers on the train. Everyone enjoyed the trip and asked about doing a fall trip.

June 13- Hike at Mendon Ponds during the Outdoor Expo. Chauncy led a seven mile hike around the park.

Multi-use trail signs for Victor have been ordered by Brian Emelson. They will be placed at the road crossings on the Auburn and Lehigh Trails.

New trail maps. Jeff volunteered to create a new up-to-date map that can be printed from our website.

GPS for VHT trail use. Jeff has found one for \$242.00 that has all the features we need and is compatible with the software he has. Dave W. will check on purchasing one from Walmart.

GRTC will be dissolving by the end of 2009. Jeff wants to keep the domain names alive so he has purchased www.grtcinc.com for \$50.00 and will check on www.grtcinc.org when it is available. Motion by Jeff, seconded by Chauncy and approved to reimburse Jeff \$50.00.

PAYPAL- Jeff has investigated the possibility of making donations to VHT on the website using PayPal. PayPal keeps about 3% on each transaction. So if someone makes a \$10 donation, we will get \$9.70. Motion by Jeff, seconded by Chauncy and approved to have Jeff add a button to the website for donations through PayPal.
