## National Trails Day 2020 in Victor



National Trails Day is a day of public events aimed at advocacy and trail service. It is also the largest event of the year for VHT. On Saturday, June 6th, Victor Hiking Trails will show off the new Farmington extension of the Auburn Trail in the morning, followed by other trails in Victor.

Hikers of all abilities

should gather at the Mertensia Road Park at 8:30 a.m. for a continental breakfast before heading out to the Auburn Trail shortly after 9:00 a.m. There will be a water and snack break, with a free pizza and drinks lunch in the Mertensia Road Park Lodge. A drawing for door prizes will take place during lunch. The afternoon hike will start at 1:00 p.m. and return to the Lodge by 3:00 p.m.

Everyone who completes all of the hikes will be rewarded with a free annual membership to VHT.

All hikes meet at Victor Town Hall rear parking lot, 85 East Main Street, unless otherwise noted. Most hikes are relatively easy and take 2-3 hours. Always bring a snack and something to drink. Dress for the weather. We rarely cancel due to inclement weather.

We usually carpool to the trailhead. Expect to share the cost of gas with the driver. If you have any questions regarding any of the hikes, or if you have suggestions for places to hike, please leave a message at the VHT Message Line, 585-234-8226.

Again this year we have scheduled several hikes in Victor or the surrounding communities. We are also leading shorter and easier hikes to encourage families and younger hikers to join us. Based on the success of past years we will again be adding an educational element to some of the hikes.

We only hike as fast as the slowest hikers, so don't worry about not keeping up. If we need to split into more than one group, that is not a problem. **Come enjoy the fun.** 

**NOTE:** There are several hiking Meetup groups in our area that schedule hikes in Victor. If you like to hike, join those Meetup groups as well.

## **Past Hikes**

Jan 11, 9 a.m.— Harriet Hollister Spencer Memorial State Recreation Area— This place is well known for its abundance of snow in the winter because of its high elevation compared to the surrounding areas. But this has been an unusual season, so the group of eight found mostly frozen ground and some ice on the trails. They still enjoyed the morning hike, the view of the lake and lunch in Honeoye.





Feb 8, 9 a.m.— Fishers Park— This was the first of two hikes scheduled for this day, which just happened to coincide with the Victor Winter Fest. Plus there was a winter fat tire bike ride, just to please everyone. And finally some snow for the snowshoe and cross-country fans.

Mar 14, 8 a.m.-Cumming Nature Center—A beautiful spring morning to hike on the trails that are normally reserved for cross-country skiing at this time of the year. The trails were a combination of dry, wet, frozen and muddy. Six hikers traversed 6.8 miles on a brisk morning. The museum has a fascinating display of local wildlife and native American history.


## **Thank you Carol MacInnis**

## **New Board Members**

The VHT Board of Directors welcomes Paul Kneer and Scott Reinhart to the Board. They have signed on to be Co-Trailmasters. They will be coordinating with the Victor Parks and Recreation Department and the Victor Parks and Recreation Advisory Committee to move forward on the Town's Master Plan to make more connections through the development of new trails. The Master Plan has several areas of the town that are lacking good alternate means of transportation. These new trails will enhance our system of trails and provide more opportunities for exercise and well being for our residents and guests. Thank you Paul and Scott for volunteering to fill this important position on the Board.

Director Jeff Miller has expressed a desire to become our Education Hike Coordinator. That leaves us with an opening for **Volunteer Coordinator**. This person will be responsible for contacting people on our list of volunteers and signing them up for a variety of events. Typical events include National Trails Day, Hang Around Victor Day, Winter Fest, Maple Fest, trail construction, trail improvements and trail counts.

If this is something you could help us with, please contact us by phone or website. We meet once a month on the third Thursday at 7:00 p.m. at Victor Town Hall. We invite you to attend a board meeting, meet the board members and learn more about this position.





## **Trail Races in Victor**

VHT will be helping with several trail races this summer. The first one is an old favorite; the 0spf scheduled for July 11. As in past years, the runners will start and finish at Valentown Museum. Approximately 120 participants will run on our Seneca Trail heading north to Perinton where they will be on a section of the Crescent Trail. This is a very challenging race with many hills to navigate. When they reach Kreag Road, they will turn around and return on the same trail, completing 13.1 miles, a half marathon. Food, drinks and prizes will await the finishers.

The second race, the Unlimited Breadsticks, sponsored by Olive Garden Restaurant, is scheduled for September 27. Contestants will start at the south end of Boughton Park and follow our Seneca Trail north to Valentown Museum, a distance of 13.1 miles. Pasta, salad, breadsticks and drinks will be ready for the approximately 120 runners.

The third race is a new one for Victor. The new Fleet Feet store near Valentown will accept up to 120 entries, split them into two groups and direct one group to the north and one group to the south, all on the Seneca Trail. After running approximately 3.3 miles, each group will return to Valentown and then run the other half of the trail for a total of 13.1 miles.

If you see any problems on the Seneca Trail, or any of the other trails, please bring it to our attention so we can keep all of our trails in great and safe condition.
