Lilac, Japanese Tree

Syringa reticulata

- Deciduous large shrub or small tree
- Stiff, spreading branches
- Rounded crown
- 20' to 30' tall
- 15' to 25' wide
- Medium growth rate
- Prefers full sun
- Prefers well-drained, slightly acidic soil
- Simple, dark green leaves
- 2" to 5" long
- Leaves out early in spring
- Off-white, fragrant flowers
- Blooms in early summer
- Flowers are in large clusters
- Up to a foot long, up to 10" wide
- Capsules borne in large clusters
- Capsules are a tan color
- Bark is a gray-brown
- Stout stems, shiny brown
- Prune after flowering
- Cut off old flower heads
- Somewhat resistant to mildew, scales and borers
- Does not have as severe of a pest problem as other Lilacs
