Birch, River

Betula nigra

- Deciduous
- Medium sized tree, 50' to 70'
- Rounded to irregular crown
- Many are multi-stemmed
- Medium to fast growth rate
- Requires full sun, moist soil
- Makes best growth on moist river bottom soil, but has proven to be adaptable to dried sites
- Leaves are lustrous medium or dark green
- Somewhat diamond-shaped
- Yellow leaves drop quickly in the fall
- Bark develops creamy orange that exfoliates in large thin sheets; bark is showy
- On very old trunks and branches bark turns brown and develops ridges and furrows
- Shade is light and allows turf to grow
- Useful along streams, in naturalistic areas
- Good for showy bark, especially during dormant season
