Oak, Pin Oak, Swamp

Quercus palustris

- Large, deciduous tree
- 75' tall and 40' wide pyramidal shape when young
- Oval to gumdrop-shape when older
- Unique branching pattern; lower branches pendulous, middle, branches horizontal, upper branches upright and spreading
- Alternate leaf arrangement
- Leaves with sharply-pointed lobes
- 3" to 6" long leaves
- Matures to a shiny, dark green
- Autumn leaves are russet, red or bronze
- Flowers are pale yellow-green
- Acorns mature in 2 years
- Main trunk with shallow ridges and furrows
- Color is gray brown
- Needs adequate room to develop
