Discussion: should name be changed to Special Event Coordinator

Action: will give more thought to position, who might be known to have the skills and personality; possibly someone who routinely joins Library Walkers. Reach out to some of the people who are active rather than just announce an opening exists.

TRAILMASTER Scott Rheinhart

- Silverton Glenn-Met with 2 reps from HOA (5/7). HOA looking for safer and more convenient pedestrian & biking to access to Village of Victor. They will approach Village of Victor. Also will talk to their HOA about the benefits of being members of VHT but rep says they have no money; explanation to rep that it could be a special arrangement with VHT, but individual members of HOA would still be paying for the membership... Concern expressed for speed limit but little positive response from state that would need to be involved in any speed change above village limit.
- VHT HOF 2024 Inductees 3 new inductees have been selected. Dave will notify inductees/family; Also Friend of VHT is Jack Marron will attend NTD June 1. Names to be announced on June 1; Formal induction at fall dinner.
- Home for the VHT HOF-Intersection of Maple and Auburn. Dave has proposed individualized paving stones. Possible east of cement pad right along side of trail. Possible few lights at the site. Process: 1. Create design/plan 2. Input from Brian 3. Submit to Village for approval. 4. Purchase & installation
- Future Trails- Met with Brian to review and improve the map of current/future trails. The results have been resubmitted to Labella. Once the map is completed, it will be given to the Town (Planning Board) as a reference for future development. Not ready to move forward to look for easements, should wait for developers to start process of looking for easement for trails, but don't always have the information to start process early enough.
- Reimagine Victor Update: Some frustration over the Village's lack of support for the establishment of a Main St. LLC.

TRAIL BOSS: Chauncy Young

- Billy Goat has arrived and has been used. Chauncy gave detailed description of function and comparison with Old Billy Goat.
- **MOTION:** Dave made motion that old Billy Goat (1997) now replaced with new brush hog be donated to TrailsRoc. Seconded by Chauncy, motion passed.
- 2 old chainsaws that were given to VHT currently not working. Old Echo chainsaw, 2007, currently getting things done.
- Time for VHT to determine what manufacturer should be used to standardize battery powered equipment
- Leaf blower and string trimmer (2020 & 2023) not needing replacement now, unless there is desire to replace gas power for battery powered
- Hedge Trimmers (2014 & 2017) should also look at new battery operated replacement

- Trailer: 2003 still working and passed inspection, but difficult to get into storage unit. Might consider new enclosed 6x12 single axle trailer. Could be stored outdoors with tools in the vehicle
- Tent: New top and bag for old tent arrived this week. Will schedule a time to get replaced before NTD
- Apple Farm Flooding: Scout Logan getting paper work done. Probably July start. Also scouted out temporary trail and bridge location-while waiting for scout project and response from owner of Apple Farm.
- Maintenance for May is scheduled. May move Monday time back to afternoon or evening-having less response from volunteers for early morning time.
- **Discussion**-should wood trail sign posts be changed to metal, **Action**: due to considerably higher cost in particular, posts will remain wood, that Chauncy can supply cutting up available wood.

NEW BUSINESS:

New grants available from USDOT & T-Mobile geared to help small towns across America thrive and grow; Lisa will send email with info to Scott to bring to Victor HUB - VHT has some ideas but need a grant writer
