Updated by-laws

Mike Rice will interview Barb in August. Scott to follow

- Lehigh update
 - Volunteers becoming more difficult to find for work parties, but part of that has to do with July being vacation time, and many other competing work parties and events
 - Barb has meeting scheduled with Brian Emelson the end of July to review progress and perhaps make a few requests. Literature suggests 10-20' buffers around ponds. That might help additional growth of the vital native plants around Lehigh's pond.
 - Barb will meet with CAC at the 9/24 meeting to give an update of what is happening at Lehigh.
 - Barb has posted a "Pollinator Habitat" sign in the area of the wooden bench near the pond, which has been an area of the most extensive work, and with many native plants emerging from the shadow of invasives on their own. Hope to add additional informative signage over the next months
- Data Collection for trails
 - Discussion of possible purchase of more counters-ideally another 5 counters would be useful to have data showing how often and where trails are being used
 - This information should be very useful for grant applications

- o New counters would be \$500.00 each, a significant amount considering VHT budget
- Action Item: Continue to document usage of trails with current counters at least until one year of data collection has been achieved. Then may move counters to other sites, or purchase additional counters.
